SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Yemen

SUBMITTED TO: The Security Council

The Security Council,

- 1 *Recognizing* the extent of the humanitarian crisis in Yemen,
2 *Reaffirming* the need for a cease fire between Saudi Arabia, Yemeni forces and the Houthi organization,
3 *Emphasizing* the extenuating need for additional aid and assistance, especially due to the ongoing COVID-19
4 pandemic,
5 *Further recognizing* that peace within the region cannot be attained without collaboration between parties
6 within the area,
7 1. *Calls on* all actors involved to allow and protect humanitarian and developmental aid, as well as aid
8 workers and non-combattants, to flow freely and unobstructed throughout Yemen under the condition that no arms
9 shall be included;
10 2. *Recommends* further stabilization efforts within the region to ensure that existing and future humanitarian
11 and peacekeeping efforts are productive and self-sustaining;
12 3. *Strongly urges* a cessation of violence, to occur in the following order:
13 (a) Saudi Arabia ceases air strikes;
14 (b) The Houthi cease missile attacks, and engage in a ground ceasefire;
15 (c) Saudi Arabia lifts its blockade of Yemen;;
16 4. *Encourages* Saudi Arabia, Yemen, and the Houthis to join in long-term peace talks;
17 5. *Calls* for immediate distribution of humanitarian aid, including but not limited to, health services, food,
18 and clean water in Yemen;
19 6. *Strongly advises* the distribution of humanitarian aid be emphasized in the cities of Sana'a, Ta'iz, Al
20 Hudayah, and Hajjah;
21 7. *Decides* to establish the United Nations Forces in Yemen (UNFIY), a UN peacekeeping operation, if a
22 ceasefire is established, with the consent of Yemen and the Houthi, to maintain peaceful relations and facilitate the
23 equitable distribution of aid to civilian populations, for a period of twelve months.
