SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Afghanistan

SUBMITTED TO: The Security Council

The Security Council,

1 *Remembering* Resolution 1401(2002) of 28 March 2002, unanimously adopted by the Security Council in
2 March of 2002, to establish United Nations Assistance Mission in Afghanistan (UNAMA),

3 *Recognizing* the recent report from the Special Representative for Afghanistan to the Security Council,

4 *Highlighting* the good will of parties in the region to protect UN Missions to help the civilians of Afghanistan,

5 *Recognizing* that Afghanistan is on the brink of a starvation crisis with 22.8 million people facing acute food
6 insecurity this winter,

7 *Noting with regret* the impacts that the recent COVID-19 pandemic has had on the people of Afghanistan
8 in addition to the hunger crisis,

9 1. *Encourages* the international community to raise funds to increase the UNAMA's capability to distribute
10 aid to the people of Afghanistan, allowing for:

- 11 (a) Increased distribution sites in rural areas;
12 (b) Increased food and water to the region;
13 (c) Increased medical aid to the civilian population;
14 (d) Increased accessibility to housing;

15 2. *Calls upon* the international community to contribute to COVID-19 Vaccines Global Access (COVAX),
16 allowing the program to:

- 17 (a) Increase distribution sites of the COVID-19 vaccine;
18 (b) Increase the amount of COVID-19 vaccinations available at these sites;

19 3. *Expands* the aid mission in Afghanistan to help secure distribution sites alongside coordinated domestic
20 assistance in the distribution of developmental and humanitarian aid:

- 21 (a) *Extends* UNAMA an additional six months until September 17th of 2022;
22 (b) *Acknowledges* that all further communications between the parties involved will be through the
23 existing Special Envoy on behalf of the United Nations;
24 (c) *Directs* UNAMA to conduct further cooperation and communication with the current parties
25 involved in the region;

26 4. *Further requests* funding from the global community to increase the assistance mission on the ground in
27 order to make possible the changes outlined in operative clauses 1, 2, and 3;

28 5. *Decides* to remain actively seized on the matter.
