Statement by the President of the Security Council

1 At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 26th of November, 2021, in connection with the Council's 2 consideration of the item entitled "The Situation in Sudan," the President of the Security Council made the following 3 statement on behalf of the Council:

The international community is observing the developing situation in Sudan with a close eye, and echoes the sentiments of UN High Commissioner for Human Rights Michelle Bachelet. Recalling the Security Council Presidential statement S/PRST/2021/20, the Security Council reiterates its commitment to peaceful government and the due process of law. Recognizing the evidence of human rights violations, the council calls for a continued assurance of civilian governance.

9 Furthermore, the Security Council calls for the swift release of all arrested and detained since the military 10 takeover and additionally urges the reinstatement of all media outlets and resources in Sudan. The Security Council 11 further urges restraint and calm on all sides. The Security Council anticipates with gladness the resumption of free 12 and fair civilian elections in 2023.

13 The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.
