Statement by the President of the Security Council

1 At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 22nd of November, 2021, in connection with the Council's
2 consideration of the item entitled "The Situation in Ethiopia," the President of the Security Council made the
3 following statement on behalf of the Council:

4 The UN Security Council is deeply concerned with the escalations in Ethiopia. Over the past days, fighting
5 has moved increasingly closer to the densely populated capital of Ethiopia, Addis Ababa. Without an end to the
6 fighting, mass starvations are likely to worsen due to constricted allocation of resources and aid. This council calls
7 for an immediate cease-fire in order to bring all parties involved to peace talks in a neutral third party's territory,
8 and to allow humanitarian aid to be dispersed through the area. This Council urges that both parties look towards
9 a diplomatic solution, and encourage conversation to bring about peace in the region. The Security Council would
10 like to recommend that a third party take part in these peace negotiations, as it is paramount that these talks lead
11 to a diplomatic end.

12 The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.
