SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Building strong institutions for sustainable development in conflict-affected countries

SUBMITTED TO: The Committee of Experts on Public Administration

*The Committee of Experts on Public Administration,*

- 1 *Being guided by* the joint effort between the United Nations and the World Bank in 2017 which created the  
2 Humanitarian Development Peace Initiative,  
3 *Emphasizing* the importance of state sovereignty,  
4 *Recognizing* the need to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) in conflict affected areas,  
5 1. *Urges* states to renew the Humanitarian Development Peace Initiative;  
6 2. *Strongly Urges* that Member States modify the previous initiative with respect to state sovereignty,  
7 shifting to a five year checking system, which looks only at the progress of the sustainable development goal self  
8 reported statistics which is being focused on;  
9 3. *Additionally Calls* for Member States to commit to more foreign direct investment into conflict affected  
10 countries;  
11 4. *Encourages* member states to continue working together to help conflict-affected areas and ensure SDG  
12 16 is completed:  
13 (a) *Further Underlines* the importance of the “No Country left behind” initiative with the SDGs;  
14 (b) *Expresses its hope* for completion of the SDGs and ensuring member states achieve world col-  
15 laboration.
