SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Strategy for youth and adult literacy (2020-2025)

SUBMITTED TO: The United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization

The United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization,

1 *Observing* the need of funding to increase global literacy rates,

2 *Confident* that the cooperation amongst Member States will be beneficial to fellow Member States,

3 *Seeking* help with the administration of schools to find the best curriculum within the budget given,

4 *Encouraging* the ability of Member States to be involved in this venture, no matter how small the contribu-
5 tion,

6 *Fully aware* this is a voluntary fund for Member States to contribute to, while also acknowledging the need
7 for resourceful countries and outside organizations to provide financial support,

8 1. *Endorses* help from non-government organizations that Member States are a part of such as the World
9 Literacy Foundation, Room to Read, Pratham;

10 2. *Strongly urges* Member States to make voluntary financial donations to the collective pool allotted according
11 to what Member States deem appropriate;

12 3. *Welcomes* the allocation of funds into a collective pool for Member States to contribute to and request
13 from by;

14 4. Completing a legal form of how much money is being given to the collective pool;

15 5. Sending a formal request through paperwork provided about why the money is needed for the improvement
16 of schools and where the money will specifically be going;

17 6. *Urges* any funds allocated are used explicitly for programs and resources relating to increasing literacy in
18 the countries that request help.
