The United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization,

- 1 Observing the need of funding to increase global literacy rates,
- 2 Confident that the cooperation amongst Member States will be beneficial to fellow Member States,
- 3 Seeking help with the administration of schools to find the best curriculum within the budget given,
- Encouraging the ability of Member States to be involved in this venture, no matter how small the contribu-
- Fully aware this is a voluntary fund for Member States to contribute to, while also acknowledging the need for resourceful countries and outside organizations to provide financial support,
- 8 1. Endorses help from non-government organizations that Member States are a part of such as the World 9 Literacy Foundation, Room to Read, Pratham;
- 2. Strongly urges Member States to make voluntary financial donations to the collective pool alloted according to what Member States deem appropriate;
- 3. Welcomes the allocation of funds into a collective pool for Member States to contribute to and request from by:
 - 4. Completing a legal form of how much money is being given to the collective pool;
- 5. Sending a formal request through paperwork provided about why the money is needed for the improvement of schools and where the money will specifically be going;
- 6. *Urges* any funds allocated are used explicitly for programs and resources relating to increasing literacy in the countries that request help.
