Statement by the President of the Security Council

At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 18th of February, 2003, in connection with the Council's consideration of the item entitled "Open Agenda," the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council:

In regard to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration Columbia Mission tragedy, the United Nations Security Council President would like to express the following sentiments. Our hearts ache for the families of the brave astronauts who made the ultimate sacrifice in the pursuit of knowledge and exploration. In this moment of profound sorrow, let us stand together as a united and resilient global community, offering our deepest condolences and unwavering support for the grieving families. Their pain is shared by all, and in this time of tragedy, let us reaffirm our commitment to the spirit of discovery and the enduring strength of humanity.

The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.
