The Security Council,

Recalling all its previous resolutions on Israel and Palestine, including resolutions 242 (1967), 338 (1973), 446 (1979), 452 (1979), 465 (1980), 471(1980), 476 (1980), 478 (1980), 1397 (2002), 1515 (2003), 1850 (2008), 2334 (2016), and 2712 (2023),

4 *Reaffirming* its strong commitment to the sovereignty, independence, and territorial integrity of all states in 5 the region,

6 *Expressing* its deep concern about the escalating tensions and the humanitarian situation in the region,

7 *Condemning* all forms of violence and hostility directed against civilians,

8 *Recognizing* the need for a durable peace through direct negotiations between the parties,

9 1. Calls For the immediate and unconditional release of all hostages held in the region and safely transported 10 to established safe zones, emphasizing that their safety and well-being are of utmost importance;

12 2. *Requests* the immediate establishment of safe zones, under United Nations supervision, to ensure the 12 unimpeded delivery of humanitarian aid to affected populations, and stresses the importance of respecting these 13 zones as neutral territories;

3. *Encourages* the Secretary-General to appoint a Special Representative to facilitate moderated negotiations between the Israeli and Palestinian leadership, with the aim of achieving a comprehensive and lasting peace based on the two-state solution;

4. Urges all parties to respect international humanitarian law and human rights law and to ensure the protection of civilians, including women, children and minority groups;

5. *Supports* the initiative for a peace conference to be held, under United Nations auspices, inviting all relevant stakeholders to discuss and negotiate terms for a lasting peace;
