- 1 Recalling all its relevant resolutions on the situation in Middle East, including the Palestinian question,
- 2 Expressing grave concern on the deteriorating situation in the Gaza Strip,
- Recognizing the impact of the conflict on neighboring countries and arising threats on the stability of the 4 region,
- Recalling that a lasting solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict can only be achieved through peaceful means under article of the Charter of the United Nations,
  - Recalling further its commitment to a two-state solution, with two democratic states of Israel and Palestine cohabitating,
- *Reaffirming* its strong commitment to the sovereignty, independence, unity and territorial integrity of Israel, and to the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations,
- Determining that the devastating humanitarian situation in Gaza continues to constitute a threat to peace towards vulnerable people in the region,
- 1. Calls upon all parties to the present fighting to cease all firing and terminate all military activity immediately, no later than 24 hours after the moment of the adoption of this decision, in the positions they now occupy;
  - 2. Calls for an immediate ceasefire for the duration of five days;
  - 3. Strongly condemns all violence directed against civilians and all acts of terrorism;
- 4. Calls for the secure release of Israeli hostages, to the number of seventy-five, prioritizing women and children;
- 5. Calls on the unimpeded provision and distribution of humanitarian aid, including the delivery of fuel every day during the five days of the ceasefire 160,000 Liters;
- 6. Decides to remain actively seized of the matter.
