Mid-Conference Update! Just some stuff to know about Monday and Tuesday

Greetings from the AMUN Secretariat. We hope your Conference has been going well so far! This is a very brief set of reminders for what's up on Monday and Tuesday. Monday is by far one of the busiest days at Conference, so please make sure you check the agenda and see what special sessions or events apply to your or your delegations.

Monday 17 November

What's on the Agenda?

- **Final FA/Perm Rep Meeting.** From 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. in the Mayfair Room on Level 2. This meeting is about AMUN conferences in the future, general conference concerns and your chance to provide feedback on anything that wasn't covered in the Rules or Hotel Issues meetings.
- **2019 Delegation Lottery.** From 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the Mayfair Room. It's your chance to get the "best" or "most interesting" countries for 2019. The annual lottery is the only way for you to try and nab your favorite picks for next year.
- **Graduate School and Career Expo.** From 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. on the Ballroom Promenade on Level 4. Encourage your students to attend our annual Expo where they can meet with recruiters from schools and organizations from across the country.
- **Committee on the Agenda.** From 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m in the Mayfair Room. AMUN's annual Committee on the Agenda is your chance to provide feedback on this year's AMUN topics and give your input on the topics for 2019. Talk with your students and see if they have feedback you can pass along. Please consider attending this important planning meeting, every bit of feedback we get makes it easier to plan for a successful Conference next year.

What's on the Agenda?

- **AMUN's Home Government and Delegate Services Offices Close.** These offices close at 11:00 a.m. so AMUN staff has time to make the final packets for the Plenary sessions in the afternoon.
- The Plenary Session of the UN General Assembly. Starting at 1:00 p.m. in the Sheraton and Chicago ballrooms located on level 4, the General Assembly Plenary will hear reports from the World Health Organization and vote on resolutions from the GA Committees.
- The Plenary Session of the Economic and Social Council. Also starting at 1:00 p.m. the ECOSOC plenary will convene to discuss reports and recommended resolutions from the Commission on Population and Development (CPD) and the Committee for Development Policy Executive Group (CDPEG).
- **Closing Plenary and Simulation Awards.** Starting at 3:15 p.m., the Closing Plenary session will feature remarks from the 2018 Secretary-General, Nia Indelicato, and will present the award recipients for the overall best delegation awards. We will also announce the simulations specific awards via handout.
