Information about the Delegation Lottery *Fees Increase for 2020 Lottery*

It's never too early to think about 2020! On Monday 25 November AMUN's Delegation Lottery will be held from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the Mayfair Room. It's your chance to get the "best" or "most interesting" countries for 2020. The annual lottery is the only way for you to try and nab your favorite picks for next year, and the atmosphere of anticipation and excitement and disappointment is hard to beat. The Lottery fee for 2020 countries is \$100.00. You can pay your 2020 Lottery Fee at any point from now until Sunday, 24 November at 9:00 p.m., if you want to go ahead and register for the lottery now, you can do so at <https://www.amun.org/shop/>.

Applying to Participate in the Lottery

Lottery [applications](#) are due before 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, 24 November 2019. Applications must be turned in at the Executive Office (Ohio Room). The \$100 deposit is required for each country requested, and this will be applied toward the school's 2020 fees. The deposit is non-refundable.

How The Lottery Works

All schools that enter the lottery will be randomly selected for first choice of country assignments. The school that is drawn to select first will automatically receive its first choice of one country assignment. Each successive school will receive their first choice, unless it has already been assigned, in which case they will receive their second choice, and so on. Schools that register for more than one delegation will be placed in the initial lottery for one delegation, and additional delegations will be assigned in subsequent rounds.
