Simulation Guide Opt-In

AMUN's Simulation Guide — also known as Model UN in a Box — is available to all schools that have registered a delegation for the 2022 Conference. It has been written and designed by AMUN staff to help you train your students who will be attending Model UN Conferences. In addition to general MUN lesson plans and resources, it also introduces specifics about AMUN rules and procedures and research and preparation.

The current printed edition of the Simulation Guide was published in 2014, so if you have a copy already, we kindly ask that you help us make an environmental and budget friendly choice to opt-out of receiving another copy. The digital supplement to the Simulation Guide was new in 2021 and can be made available to all participants separate from the physical book. The digital supplements allow you to practice three simulations, the: Commission on the Status of Women, General Assembly Third Committee and the Security Council of 2021.
