ICJ: The Question of Colonialism, Rejected by Majority in Nicaragua v Colombia

The majority opinion of the International Court of Justice (the Court) ruled in Nicaragua v Colombia; Honduras and Costa Rica that Nicaragua must respect the validity of the Esguerra-Bárceñas Treaty signed during the United States' occupation of Nicaragua.
