For Faculty Advisors: Your Role & Ways to Get Involved

Faculty Advisor Guidelines

In response to feedback from students and faculty over the years, AMUN has an [official policy](#) on roles and participation by faculty advisors.

Faculty advisors play a key role in preparing delegations before the Conference and offering support with both logistics and research. During the Conference, advisors should model professionalism and act as a resource for their students—ideally outside of official session times and committee rooms.

Please note:

- Faculty are not representatives and may not participate in debate, caucusing or resolution drafting.
- They may not sit at a delegation's placard or engage with other schools on committee matters.
- Advisors are welcome to observe formal debate from gallery seating at the back of committee rooms.
